McNabs and Lawlor Islands Provincial Park has limited services. Drinking water is not available on the island. Pit toilets are situated at several locations. The weather tends to be variable and cooler than on the nearby mainland.

There are no waste management facilities on the island. Pack-in and pack-out garbage and recyclables.

PARK SAFETY

- Bicycles are restricted to the main roads; motorized vehicles are prohibited.
- Please keep pets on a leash at all times.
